Screening begins March 1, 2019; position remains open until filled

Description:

~As one of three conductors, serve on panel for auditions in May and late August

~Full responsibility for selection of repertoire, conducting weekly rehearsals on Monday evenings and two concerts (each concert performed twice)/academic year
(one concert with one repeat performance/semester)

~Position begins in late August, 2019

~Typical schedule includes 10 rehearsals in fall (September through November) with concerts in mid-November, and 8-9 rehearsals in winter/spring (January through early March, with concerts in late February or early March)

~Pay is negotiable, dependent on experience

~Optional additional work as Coach for small ensembles (string quartets, etc.) in EYO's annual Chamber Music program (selection of repertoire, coaching small ensembles in rehearsals and performances from mid-November through early December)
(Additional pay for work as chamber music Coach, dependent on variable student enrollment)

Qualifications:

~Experience in teaching string music to children required

~Bachelor's Degree in Music, or equivalent, required

~Working knowledge of all string instruments; knowledge of Suzuki methodology desirable

~Background check required prior to employment

~Send letter of application, and resume that details your own education and your teaching experience in music, along with complete contact information for three references with knowledge of your recent work,

as well as an **optional recording** (either video recording or audio recording) of your work (or an internet link to a video recording or audio recording of your work) as a conductor or teacher of a children's orchestra by **March 1, 2019**, to:
